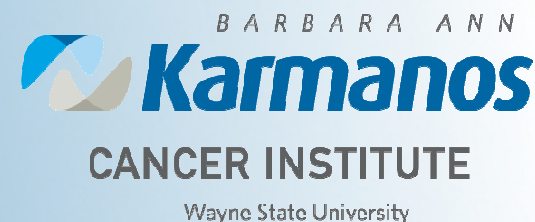

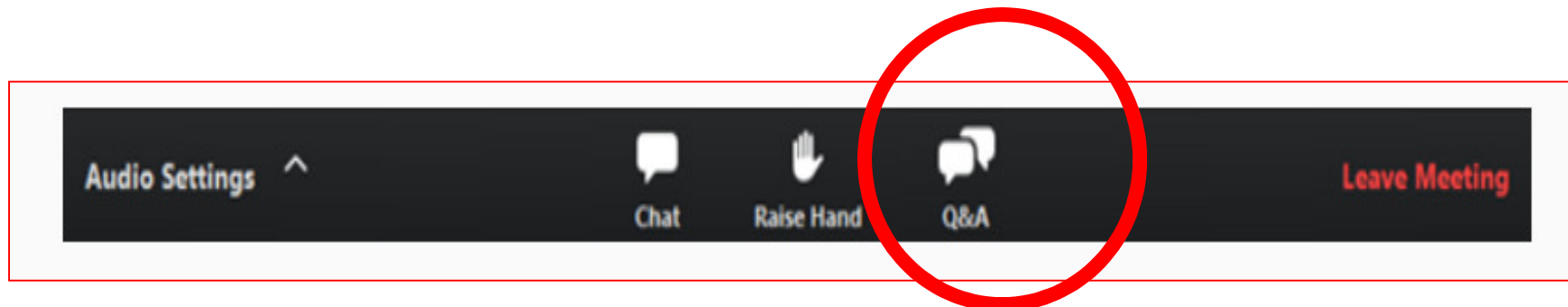


Asking a Question

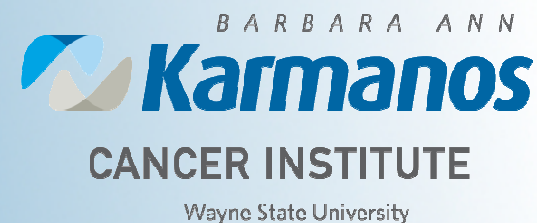

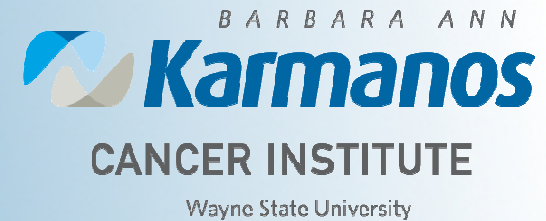

What to Expect at Cancer Treatments Centers



Our patients' safety and health continue to be our priority

- Single entry point
- No visitors permitted
- Everyone is screened
 - Travel history
 - Risk of exposure to COVID-19
 - Cough
 - Fever
 - Shortness of breath
 - Diarrhea and vomiting
 - Conjunctivitis
 - Loss of sense of smell/taste

Additional Precautions Taken at Cancer Centers

- All staff are wearing masks
- Non essential employees are working from home
- Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) as appropriate
 - In short supply
 - McLaren is sourcing and securing
- Rescheduling all visits, procedures and tests for patients not on active treatment/with no significant medical problems
- Continuing to see active treatment patients and newly diagnosed
- Now offering Telehealth appointments

Further Precautions for Staff and Patients

- Proper hand hygiene (20 seconds)
- Disinfect surfaces between visits
- Cover cough and sneeze
- PPE as appropriate
- Social/physical distancing

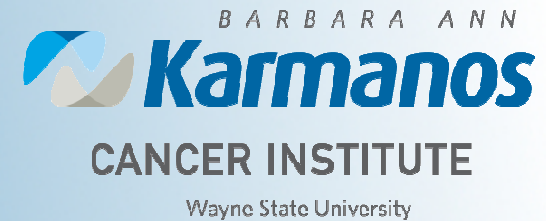
If you are ill, please stay home and call your physician for further instructions

- ✓ Take breaks from TV and Social Media

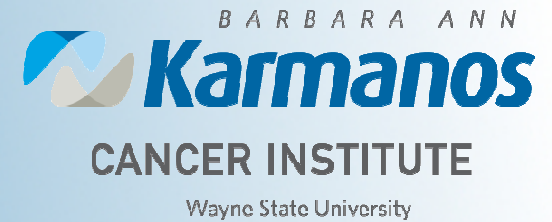
