



## MCLAREN BIRTHING CLASSES

Expectant parents have the unique opportunity to participate in McLaren Greater Lansing's labor support class, held at The Birthplace, our labor and delivery unit at the hospital. This one-day course is led by our nurses from the The Birthplace and gives an exclusive perspective where patients learn more about the birthing process at McLaren along with receiving a tour of the facility to better prepare them for the big day.

The class includes a full range of preparation and techniques of laboring and post-labor care including:

- The labor process
- Hospital admission process, labor positioning, and comfort and pain control techniques
- Delivery and postpartum care
