THE IMPORTANT ROLE OF AN OB/GYN

Your OB/GYN will assist you with some of the most important health concerns of your life, including childbirth or menopause concerns.

These are often very personal issues, so it is important to find a gynecologist you trust—someone with whom you feel comfortable. Women often find the right physician by getting a referral from a friend or from their primary care physician.

Often, your primary care physician can perform some of the important screening procedures, but will offer good referral information if a specialist is needed.

- Preventive care, like pelvic exams, mammography and bone density tests

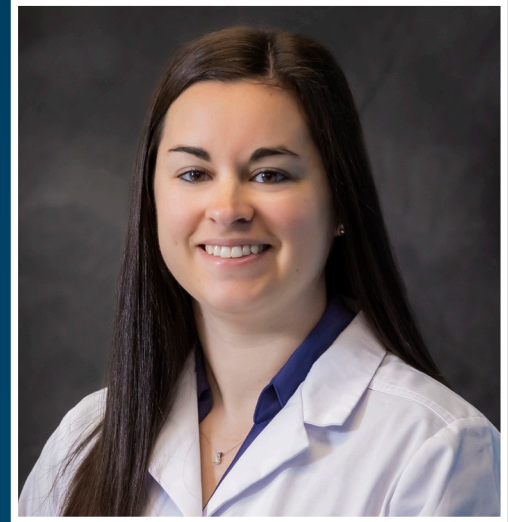
