Institutional Review Board (IRB) Fee Schedule

Effective April 1, 2024

Initial Submission	\$3,000*
Multi-site studies fee: For studies that are opened at multiple sites the lead site will be charged \$3,000 and each additional site \$1,000	\$1,000
Sub-Study	\$750
Additional fee per sub-study per site that accompanies a new submission or when a sub-study is added to an already approved study	
Continuing Review Submission	\$1,000
Multi-site studies fee: For studies that are opened at multiple sites, the lead site will be charged \$1,000 and each additional site \$750	\$750
Amendments Requiring Full Board Review	\$750
Multi-site studies fee: For studies that are opened at multiple sites, the lead site will be charged \$750 and each additional site \$500	\$500
Annual Status Report	\$500
Request to Use / Cede to External IRB	\$1,000
One-time Administrative Review & Management Fee	
Final Reports / Close Out	\$500
Protocol Deviations / Violations	\$0

Note:

McLaren Health Care IRB (MHC IRB) charges for the review of research studies supported by pharmaceutical companies and other for-profit entities.

Investigators submitting industry-sponsored research protocols are required to include in the study budget, the cost of initial protocol review, continuing review, and sponsor initiated full-board amendments requiring MHC IRB review.

IRB operations are specialized and rigorously regulated. Fees are based on the assessment of costs associated with review of protocol. All IRB fees are non-refundable fees. The charges apply regardless of whether the project is IRB-approved. Fee payments are expected to be paid in full within 30 days of invoice.
