Bone Marrow & Stem Cell Transplant Program

Karmanos Cancer Institute's Bone Marrow & Stem Cell Transplant Program was the first transplant center in Michigan. Today, it is one of the largest programs of its kind in the United

States having performed more than 1,300 transplants in the last five years. The Karmanos Cancer Institute Bone Marrow Transplantation Program is one of only a select group nationwide reporting some of the best survival outcomes for related and unrelated stem cell transplantation, according to data released.

Based on these data, the patients at Karmanos have the highest risk factors predicting their transplant would be difficult. In spite of these characteristics, the survival of the patients at Karmanos was better than predicted for the last three reporting periods. Karmanos remains the only center in Michigan which achieved this distinction and only one of six in the country which has this survival advantage over the last two reporting periods. <u>LEARN MORE</u>.
